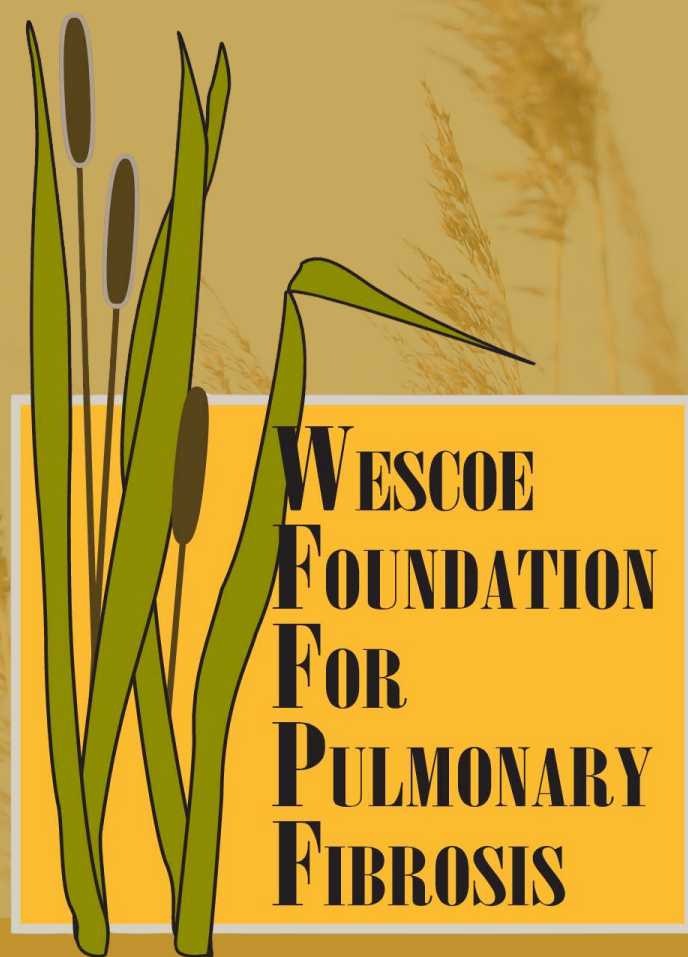

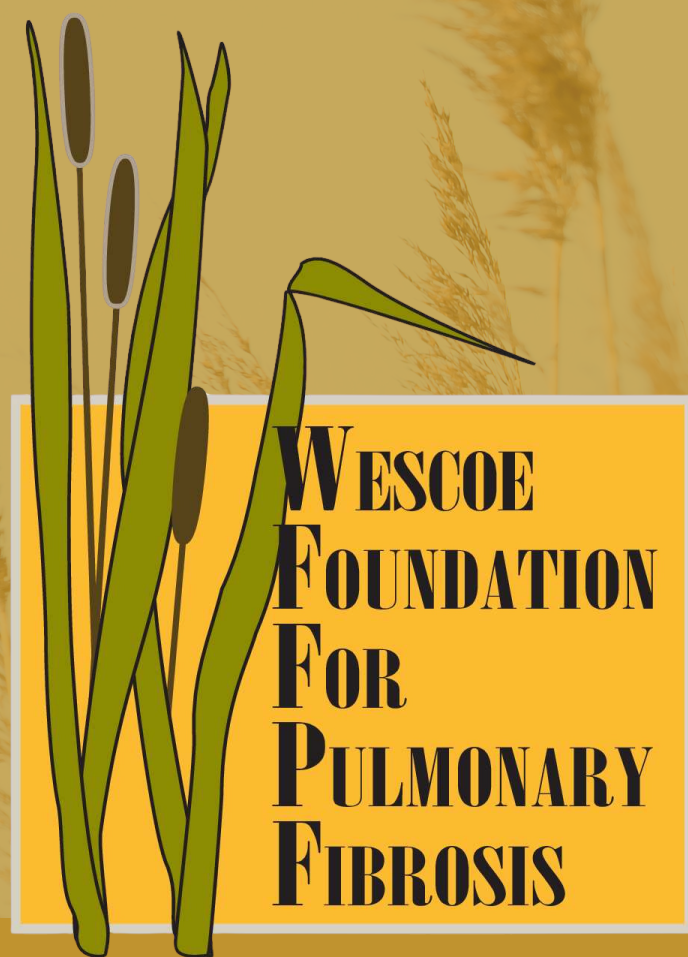
Scientific Registry of Transplant Recipients (SRTR)
